GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is registered with and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the NSSA and NYSSA. Classification will be based on NSSA rules.

It is the shooter's responsibility to present a classification card that contains a complete and accurate record of scores. All non-classified shooters will be classified in accordance with NSSA rules. JR and SJR shooters may shoot targets only, subject to NSSA rules II-B-2 and II-B-3.

The club will provide shoot off targets at its own expense; shoot off ammunition will be at the shooter's expense. Winnings will be mailed within five days following the shoot, a shoot report will be posted on the Association's website and on any other available websites as soon as all results are available (usually Monday).

The club and facilities will open Friday morning at 9:00-am. Practice fields will be available from 2:00-pm - 6:00-pm Thursday (no restaurant, no bar). and will reopen on Friday at 9:00-am. Practice will also be available throughout the weekend as permitted, but will close when shoot-offs begin. Camping is by reservation. (contact 585-533-9913) All campers will be required to pay a camping fee depending on services required.

The registration area will be open on Friday @ 1:00-pm. Shooters may register during the shoot from 9:00-am until the start of the last flight of the event to be registered. Shooters who request more than two changes to their entry or squadding after registration may be charged an administrative fee of \$5.00.

The shoot will register on-line, beginning Friday, July 17. Go to the link: to sign up and pay deposits via PayPal. There will also be an option to mail in registration and deposits.

Payment of entry fees will be conducted on the gun club porch, please observe all social-distancing guidelines.

The Shoot Committee reserves the right to alter the program as necessary. NSSA-Licensed referees will be used. It is the shooter's responsibility to check the score board daily for important notices,

program changes, shoot off and other information. Contestants and spectators assume all risk of theft, accident or adverse health outcomes.

Shooters required to report to field 15 minutes before flight time. Shoot offs will begin ASAP after the completion of the last flight of the day. Shooters will have 5 minutes from time called to report to field. Shooting glasses and ear protection are mandatory under NSSA rules and are required.

In compliance with CDC and NY State regulations, all shooters, guests, vendors and staff are required to wear face masks while inside the clubhouse. Social distancing guidelines in the clubhouse and on club grounds must be observed and will be enforced.

The clubhouse will be open throughout the shoot. The bar and restaurant facilities will be available, and patrons are advised to carry these food and drink items out to the deck and porch for enjoyment.

The Shoot and Protest Committees are: Shoot — NYSSA President, Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer and Shoot Manager. Protest — NYSSA Zone 1-5 Executive Committee persons. See Section II E for proper protest procedure.

Please keep all pets on leashes and under control.

Every 12-gauge shooter will be entered (free) into the 5-man Team Handicap Event. Short squads will be merged to ensure that all shooters are eligible to compete for the prize. Total handicap shared by team. No handicap during shootoffs.

Highest score 500x500 – ties will shoot off

No charge for Sub-Junior, Junior, or Junior Lady contestants. No charge for honors-only entry (non-residents only).

Medals to be awarded are shown on listing.

No contestant shall be eligible for more than one concurrent event based on age. Contestants entering a concurrent event based upon age must shoot in the event for which they are qualified. (e.g., Senior may not enter as Sub-Senior or Veteran.)

In Parent and Child events, the child must be less than 18 years old.

SHOOT OFF INFORMATION

All shoot offs will be one round of doubles, miss and out by station, stations 3, 4 and 5 for a total of 24 targets.

Shooters will have 5 minutes from time called to report to field.

All shoot offs will be concluded the same day or night as the event.

All ties will be shot off, including those for class medals and/or monies.

It is the shooter's responsibility to check the score board to determine status of class ties.

Individual concurrent events will be shot off simultaneously with event and class championships whenever possible.

The gun and ammo malfunction rules as per NSSA rules. NSSA doubles rules apply.

Team shoot offs will consist of doubles, as described above, total team score by station.

ORDER OF SHOOT OFFS

- 2. Concurrent Championships not determined by Championship and Class shoot off
- 3. 2-Man Team

Following the conclusion of the 410 event on Sunday, the shoot off order is as follows:

- 1. HOA Championship Tie
- 2. 28-Ga Champion, Classes, Concurrents, Teams
- 3. 410, Champion, Classes, Concurrents, Teams
- 4. Remaining HOA Classes, Concurrents, Teams
- 5. HAA Champion / Junior Ties honors only
- 6. Champ of Champs

NOTE: Management reserves the right to alter the order of shoot offs. It is the responsibility of the shooter to listen to announcements and report to the assigned field.
